Maths Intergalactic Space Travel

The following will be your child's targets.

Soon we will be travelling around the solar system collecting Maths Intergalactic Space Travel Passports. First we need to complete Space School. When you can show us 3 times that you have learnt the maths skill/concept you will receive another item in your suitcase.

Training Targets	
Recite numbers in order to 10	
Count objects to 10	
Subitise (recognising quantities without counting) up to 5	
Order numbers to 10	
Recognise numerals to 10	

Space School	Examples	Can your child answer these questions?
Recite numbers in order to 10	Join in counting rhymes and songs Start at 4 and count on to 10	Sing counting rhymes and songs together
Counts objects to 10	Count a given set of objects carefully and accurately	Learning to Count with these fun Counting Games (topmarks.co.uk) have some lovely early counting and number recognition games Count a range of objects showing the link between 1 and 2 etc. ensuring that each number counted reflects an object.
Subitise (recognising quantities without counting) up to 5	Please use your NumBots account as the many of the early activities include subitizing.	How many did you see? Can you explain the pattern you saw?
Order numbers to 10	Use a set of 0-10 flashcards and place them in order.	Can you build a number track using flashcards? Start with zero and then one. Can you build a number track when the numbers are given out of order? E.g. place the 5 and then the 8 and then the 3 etc
Recognises numerals to 10	When shown a number 4, say the number aloud and count out the matching number of objects	Can you write four on my back? Use shaving foam to write the numbers in. When out and about ask them to find a number 4 etc.
