

English

- Read, enjoy and talk about texts linked to our theme
- Learn to recognise and use nouns and adjectives to create noun phrases (e.g. a woolly sheep)
- Punctuate statement sentences correctly with full stops and capital letters
- Retell stories they have listened to
- Compare and contrast stories
- Identify vowel and consonant letters
- Learn to spell words using the GPCs: dge, ge, g, kn, gn, wr, c, le,

Science

- Understand that animals (including humans) have offspring that grow into adults
- Learn to match and name adult animals and their young
- Learn about growing through the seasons and how crops are grown
- Learn about what we need to be healthy and find out about the different food groups and a balanced diet

Design Technology

- Evaluate different fruit salads
- Design, make and evaluate a fruit salad they have made

Physical Education

- Health and Wellbeing: developing agility and co-ordination

Geography

- Learn that farms are for producing food
- Recognise the environmental features that are characteristic of a farm
- Recognise that some foods can be grown in the UK whilst others come from other parts of the world linking this to climate
- Locate continents and some countries on a map of the world

- Explore the theme of Friendship

Music

- Explore beat and rhythm in songs and pieces of music

Maths

- Explain what each digit in a 2-digit number represents
- Partition 2-digit numbers into tens and ones and find other ways of partitioning them
- Learn to read and write 2-digit numbers in numerals and words
- Sequence and position numbers in the correct place on a number line
- Order 2-digit numbers from smallest to greatest
- Use $<$, $>$ and $=$ symbols to compare numbers
- Find 10 more or 10 less than any given number
- Learn to identify pentagons, hexagons and octagons
- Identify vertical lines of symmetry in 2-D shapes
- Identify the vertices, edges and faces of 3-D shapes
